ENABLES DOCUMENT VIEWING ON WINDOWS® 8 IN SUPPORT OF MOBILE WORK

TOKYO, October 26, 2012—To facilitate communications during mobile work, Fuji Xerox Co., Ltd. will today release DocuWorks Viewer Light 1.0, a free-of-charge Windows Store app for viewing DocuWorks¹ documents. DocuWorks Viewer Light 1.0 is compatible with Microsoft's new operating software Windows® 8 and ARM® processor-installed Windows® RT released today.

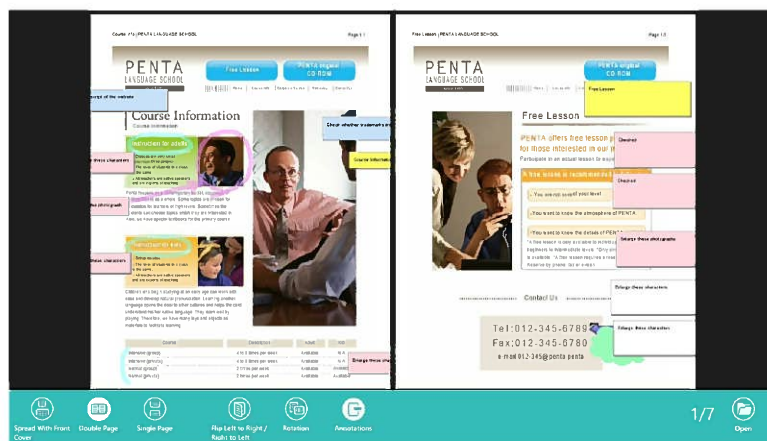


Fig. 1 Image of DocuWorks document seen with DocuWorks Viewer Light 1.0

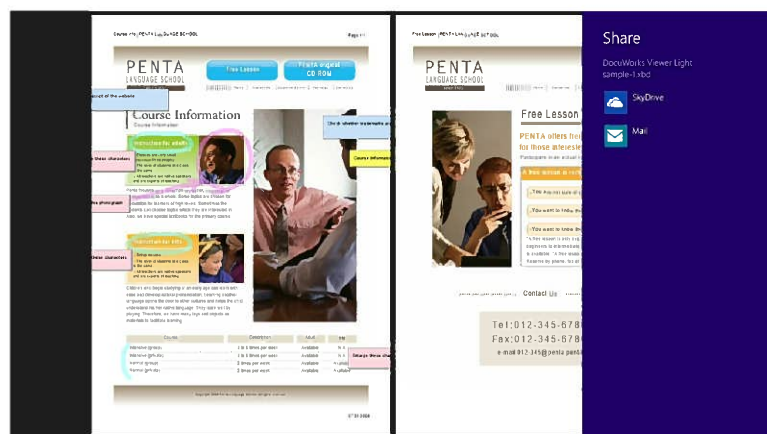


Fig. 2 Image of DocuWorks document to be transferred to other apps

Through touch operations on desktop computers and tablet devices, users can view, scroll and turn pages of DocuWorks documents as well as enlarge and shrink the document display (Fig. 1). The software also shares data between applications with the Charm function for Windows® 8 and Windows® RT, enabling DocuWorks documents to be transferred to other apps such as email and SkyDrive® (Fig. 2).
