## Fuji Xerox Taiwan Wins the Excellent Performance Enterprises Award From the Taoyuan County

### High Evaluations for Recycling and Green Procurement

**TOKYO, October 22, 2013** – Recognized for its environmental-related activities, Fuji Xerox Taiwan Corporation, a sales subsidiary of Fuji Xerox Co., Ltd., won the Evergreen Enterprises category award in the Seventh Excellent Performance Enterprises Award organized by Taoyuan County of Taiwan. The award ceremony was held on October 2, 2013.

Fuji Xerox Taiwan was highly evaluated for its green procurement that the company has been conducting over the years, along with the initiatives at its Taoyuan Factory on the Integrated Recycling System<sup>\*1</sup>. Fuji Xerox Taiwan was the first in the industry, and the only Japanese company to receive this award.

In the selection process, the judges comprising of experts from the authorities, universities and others evaluated documents submitted by candidates, as well as conducted on-site inspection, regarding indicators such as the company's corporate competitiveness, management and contribution to the local society. This year, five companies won the award as a result of the evaluation for more than one month.

Taoyuan County is located in the northeastern part of Taiwan, having an international airport and an industrial zone. Fuji Xerox Taiwan established its Taoyuan Factory as a production base for toner cartridges in 1974. After the toner cartridges production was transferred to mainland China in 2004, Taoyuan Factory started recycling activities by collecting end-of-life products and supplies from customers. In 2007, Taoyuan Factory achieved zero emission<sup>\*2</sup>, managing to recycle total 3,569.8 tons of waste by fiscal year 2012.

In recent years, Fuji Xerox Taiwan has been making efforts to support green procurement promoted by the Taiwan authorities, and is the industry's leading company in terms of the number of products credited with the Green Certificate issued by the Taiwan's Ministry of Environment. Furthermore, Fuji Xerox Taiwan received the Green Shop Award from the Taiwan's Ministry of Environment in 2010 and 2012 for the promotion of eco-purchasing activities.

Operating on the principle that CSR is synonymous with corporate management, Fuji Xerox continues to support customers' environmental management and work toward the realization of a sustainable society.

\*1: In 1995, Fuji Xerox began full operation of the Integrated Recycling System in Japan with the goals to achieve zero landfill, no pollution and zero illegal disposal, perceiving them as its responsibility as a manufacturer. The Company established the center of the system in Thailand in 2004 for countries and regions of Asia Pacific, which is Fuji Xerox's direct sales and services territory, and also in China in 2008. The Company achieved zero landfill from collected used products in Japan in 2000, in Thailand in 2010, in China in 2011, and in Korea/Australia/New Zealand in 2012.

\*2: Fuji Xerox defines zero landfill as recycling rate of more than 99.5 percent.
