Tobu-TRA collaborative programs (1st round) following the conclusion of the friendship railway accord

Tobu and TRA signed a friendship railway agreement at TRA's Taipei Station on December 18, 2015, with the aim of deepening their friendly relationship, attracting passengers and promoting exchanges in their services. In commemoration of the agreement, Tobu and TRA held departing ceremonies for their respective trains -- on which their common commemorative logo was displayed -- in Japan and Taiwan almost simultaneously.

- (1) Trains displaying common logo
- -Japan: Tobu's Limited Express SPACIA (The logo is displayed on four locations on both sides of the train.)
- -Taiwan: TRA's Tze-Chiang limited express "Puyuma" (The logo is displayed on four locations on both sides of the train.)
- (2) The logo is displayed from December 18, 2015 to December 31, 2016

- 2. Collaborative programs (1st round)
- (1) Tobu's public relations materials, such as photos, are on display on the premises of Taiwan's Taipei Station, introducing attractions in areas along the Tobu lines in four seasons to prospective visitors.

- (2) Special tickets issued in commemoration of Tobu-TRA friendship railway agreement The commemorative tickets printed on the common mat board were released on December 18, 2015.
- (3) Mutual ticket exchange program

If those who have purchased Tobu's designated special tickets or TRA's designated tickets show the tickets (or their paper wrappers) at stations designated by the two railway operators, they can receive a free or discounted ticket useful for tourism along lines operated by the two entities.
