In the Washoku World Challenge 2016, ten finalists from all over the world fly to Tokyo to prepare their original dishes and other assigned recipes and present these to a jury panel of some of Japan's most distinguished chefs, such as Kihachi Kumagai and Yukio Hattori. These jury members, alongside a number of technical judges, will critically inspect the dishes to determine their performance and the technical ability displayed in the kitchen.

The chef who receives the highest ratings will be awarded with the title of "No. 1 International Washoku Chef" at the award ceremony. After the award ceremony, a workshop seminar will be held by Japanese food producers to explain about the qualities and applications of Japanese foodstuffs, and all will have the opportunity to meet and interact. Representatives may conduct interviews with individual finalists, jury members, and the organizers.
