## Tokamachi to showcase its snow culture as tourism asset Feb. 27-28, 2017

Tokamachi City, one of the heaviest snowfall areas in Japan, will conduct a press tour for foreign correspondents stationed in the Tokyo area on **Feb. 27-28** to showcase its unique snow culture, local cuisine and artwork in snow-covered fields, as part of its effort to spread charms of the central Japan city in Niigata Prefecture.

Echigo-Tsumari region was once called "inaccessible corner on the island" because of its heavy snowfall in winter.

Participants of the press tour will see winter exhibitions of snow tools and contemporary art utilizing snow, experience making the Kamakura snow dome, trek on the snow art trail wearing snowshoes, and tour around artwork in a snowcovered field, among other things.

Artists who will exhibit their artworks along the snow art trail include Maaria Wirkkala of Finland.



Participants can also enjoy delicious local cuisine around the hearth and refreshments in the Kamakura snow dome.

Other artworks to be covered in the tour include the House of Birds by Jaume Plensa of Spain in an outdoor field.
